

Iowa City Intergroup Meeting Minutes – 7/11/26

Called to order at 10:05 am.

Attendees: Bryan D. (Chair), Dan R. (Co-Chair), Jeff N. (district liaison), Becky B. (Melrose), Tim H. (Tuesday night trudgers).

Chair Reports

Secretary (Ryan H.): June meeting minutes approved by all attending.

Treasurer/Communications (Laura H.): Treasurer's report attached, approved by all attending. Sinking fund set aside \$100 a month for future events (e.g. NYE), suggest clarifying what this is for in the report.

Chair (Bryan D.): The young people's group had trouble with the hotel for IAYPAA and the hospitality suite. Dan has an update under old business.

Co-chair (Dan R.): Dan sent out a flowchart for people answering the AA phone line and for training, and is looking for feedback. Plan to meet after Tim is back in town from traveling.

Webmaster (Ashley T.): The most recent meeting minutes and treasurers report have been uploaded. All events should also be current, including the new information for the IAYPAA Conference that had a venue change.

Phone chair (Heidi W.): Dan has the phone list and has been calling numbers and most people are responsive. It would be nice to add a few more names to the list (Tim will send Dan some names).

Intergroup district liaison (Jeff N.): Meeting minutes are on the district website for those interested (<https://iadistrict13aa.org/>). There was a recap of the area conference and a discussion on setting up a meeting with our area rep, Dan P. If anyone has an opinion, let them know. Looking into a consolidated app for AA to combine several different ones (meeting guide, etc.).

Group Reports (including emailed)

Breakfast club, Riverside and Solon (Jeff N.): Open meeting at 6 am, seven days a week, 511 Melrose in Iowa City. Meeting chairs select the reading from AA approved literature followed by shares. Attendance is strong, weekdays between 15 and 20 people, weekends around 10-15. We are doing a breakfast meeting on the 3rd Friday of every month. Riverside and Solon continue to have approximately 5 attendees, and both are doing well.

Monday night Tiffin group (Regan L.): Meets at 7 pm on Monday nights at the Grace United Methodist Church in Tiffin. Averaging around 25 attendees each week with 18 claiming us as their home group. On Monday, June 8th we held an event in celebration of the 20th anniversary of the Tiffin Monday night group (June 5th) as well as the 91st anniversary of AA (June 10th). The event went very well, bringing in around 75 attendees. The AA documentary "Markings on the journey" was shown, after which Doug B spoke about the history of AA in Iowa City/district 13. We followed the meeting with refreshments and fellowship in the fellowship hall where we normally hold our meeting. Home group members provided desserts in addition to the cake we usually serve to celebrate AA birthdays. The donation from this event was donated to IAYPAA X.

Tuesday Night Trudgers (Tim H.): Closed, literature-discussion meeting that meets at Zion Lutheran church Tuesdays, 7:30-8:30. We generally see attendance of about 25-30 people. Business meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month at Zion at 6:45PM. All are welcome to attend and become home group members.

Women's Big Book Study Group (Ashley T): Closed women's meeting that meets every Saturday at 9 am at Gloria Dei Lutheran Church. We read from the first 181 pages followed by alternating the 1st, 2nd, or 3rd section of the stories in the new edition, then share on the reading. We have approximately 15-20 women attending each week.

Sunday together we can make it (Bryan D.): Good attendance (20 or more) rotating chairperson going well.

Wednesday step study (Bryan D.): off to a good start, 8-10 people, half regulars, half rotating.

Friday night men's meeting (Bryan D.): Good attendance (25 or more), nice mix of long sobriety and newcomers

Old Business

Area 24 IAYPAA conference in Iowa City, August 14-16: Moved from the Highlander to the Graduate hotel, signup sheets for hospitality rooms/meals on the website (no hot plates or crock pots). Currently around 175 registered (hoping for closer to 450). We had talked about sponsoring a hospitality room or other donation. Looking for \$300-500, plus volunteers to cover. Could also bring in food for meals (deli sandwiches, fried chicken, picnic food), but Dan defers to the conference organizers. Bryan and Dan will talk to Regan on Sunday, then have a subcommittee meeting in a couple weeks (before the next IG meeting since that's only a week before the conference). Motion to donate \$600 to the conference, seconded and approved by all attending.

New Business

Attraction/Promotion: Jeff brought up hearing an ad for NA on Rock 108, might help getting the word out, but may tread the line of attraction vs. promotion. Tim brought up that we used to have signs/flyers on buses, and GSO has PSAs that can be used with a local phone number. Jeff will talk with the district PI chair (Megan) about it at the next district meeting.

Phone list update, script/flow chart: plan to continue to work on this in the next few months.
